Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. What?

How?

How does Dividend Solar Finance collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or give us your income information Provide employment information or apply for financing Show your driver's license
	We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- Affiliates from using your information to market to you
- Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
